Director's Message

Happy Sunday At Home Academy families,

Whew! Thank goodness the weather finally warmed up a bit. It got SOOOO cold that it was tough to get out from under the heating blanket we moved to our family room. I hope you've been able to keep warm and enjoy the snow here and there.

As you know, this was our first week of the new semester. Though our elementary students saw very little changes to their school day, our middle school students have shifted their elective and now are enjoying a new fine art. All students received an Art Kit at the start of the school year. Please have your middle schooler search through their things to find their materials so they can be prepared. For students taking Music this semester, watch for emails and ParentSquare posts from Mrs. Ogunmola, the music teacher. She will let you know what materials are needed for this term. Other classrooms may also have supplies for you to pick up for the new semester. If your child's teacher has notified you of a pickup, materials will be on the porch at our Jefferson Barracks location (69 Randolph Rd, 63125) by 8:00 am. Please contact Mrs. Beier (314-467-7850) if you need to pick up your materials on a different day.

We find that the second semester often feels like the hardest, and the meat-and-potatoes, part of the school year. Students are learning all new material, there are fewer holiday breaks, there is less opportunity to spend time taking breaks outside, the newness has all worn off, and so on. You can support your child be their best self as a learner by reviewing your expectations with them.

- Take inventory of their learning space. Do they have the materials close at hand? Is the space organized and clean? Do any materials need to be replaced?
- Discuss expectations regarding personal presence in virtual classes:
 - turn your camera on and be visible on screen (students can minimize their self-view if they don't wish to see themselves on camera)
 - o participate by raising hand to speak, using the chat, or messaging with the teacher in GoGuardian
 - complete tasks during time allotted, and, if needed, finish in the afternoon or evening as your family's schedule dictates
 - avoid other distractions during the school day (game systems, cell phones, etc.) to better stay on task
 - walk away from the Chromebook when breaks are given: stretch, play with a pet, have a conversation with a parent. Everyone needs breaks!

Discussing your expectations with your child. When possible, include them in setting those up. In the in-person classroom, goals are posted in the room and reviewed regularly. Routines / schedules are posted in the room. The world operates on a schedule, so this is a great opportunity to help your child learn how to set one that works for them and your family.




Counselor's Corner
